BEHAVIOUR	NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCE LEVEL	WHAT ARE THE NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES?	BEHAVIOUR POINTS
In lessons if you don't follow the expectations.	Level 1	Reminder of what is expected	0
If you continue, or no homework. You are late to school	Level 2	Yellow Card and / or asked to move your seat. Three occasions within a half term: Pastoral Detention	4
You choose to persist	Level 3	Red Card and move to sixth form lesson Departmental Detention	6
Refusal to go to a sixth form lesson Deliberately disobeying a member of staff, Smoking, Truancy, Damage to property, Verbal abuse, under the influence of drugs or alcohol	Level 4	A senior member of staff will come to the lesson. You will be placed in a sixth form lesson. Departmental detention and a Pastoral Manager's Detention Pastoral Manager's Detention	8
Levels 5 and 6 are rarely experienced at Shelley College			
Provoked physical assault on a student, Bullying, Theft.	Level 5	SLT Detention	10
Direct foul and abusive language to a member of staff. Unprovoked physical assault on a student. Racial / Sexual / Homophobic abuse. Drugs – possession. Students bring in a weapon. Physical assault on a member of staff.	Level 6	Fixed Term External Isolation Permanent Exclusion	12 per day 16 per day Leave College
