GCSE Mathematics – Edexcel

The study of GCSE Mathematics starts in Year 9 and is completed by the end of Y11

Students who are currently in years 9, 10 and 11 are following specifications in the new GCSE for Mathematics and these are 100% examined qualifications. Fundamentally the subject breaks into the following sections:

- Number
- Algebra
- Ratio, proportion and rates of change
- Geometry and measures
- Probability
- Statistics

All of these will also be tested from a problem solving angle. There are two tiers of entry, Foundation and Higher. Number grades are now awarded for GCSE Mathematics on a 1-9 scale, with 1 being the lowest and 9 the highest.

The content is tested by 3 exam papers each 1.5 hours in length. Paper 1 is non-calculator and Papers 2 and 3 are calculator.
