GW informed them that the following had and/or would be happening;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The catering service was advertised as an external opportunity with a view to improving what we offer on a daily basis - Numerous companies applied for that contract - Catering staff, GW and Pip Horn visited schools these companies already cater in to gather views - 3 companies were shortlisted and interviewed - Chartwells will take over the service from 1/11/2017. - The company will run regular student voice for feedback as their work develops with us <p>One student asked if we could run a film night to raise money for Riding for the Disabled. GW asked the student to follow this up and check for interest before we made further plans.</p> <p>Students asked how fundraising for the charities would work and how it has happened in the past. Feedback was given, informing students that money raised at the Christmas showcase is shared amongst charities but that we can run other events. Students are going away with a view of bringing ideas from their form.
