

Shelley College Student Leadership Meeting Minutes - 08.12.17

Joe Winter (Head Boy) was absent for medical reasons.

Meeting declared open at 12:36

Item 1 - Register

The register was conducted at the start of the meeting.

Item 2 - Charity Committee Update

Natalie Hacker of the Charity Committee came forward to update the wider group on their activities. The only business to take care of is the Christmas Showcase, as volunteers were needed to man the stalls; all profits raised will go to the Huddersfield Change Project. Student Leaders were asked to sign up at the end of the meeting.

Item 3 - Teaching and Learning Committee Update

Sam Halstead of the Teaching and Learning Committee came forward to say that, at the last meeting of the Committee, Joe Winter (Head Boy) had taken responsibility for producing a questionnaire regarding teaching and learning in lower school. However, due to his absence from the meeting, this could be taken no further and thus the Committee had no further business to discuss.

Item 4 - Sixth Form Committee Update

The Sixth Form Committee informed the wider group that they had, in coordination with Ms M Dukeson, arranged the Charity Quizmas Quiz, which will aim to raise money for the Huddersfield Change Project. However, they would like more teams to sign up for tickets, and thus asked Student Leaders to help raise awareness of the quiz and to encourage further participation.

Item 5 - Year Book Committee Update

Beth Chamberlain of the Year Book Committee told the group that the Committee had spoken to Ms L Bird (Year 11 Student Manager) and she gave them last year's yearbook for ideas. The Committee decided to plan a prototype, and have arranged a follow up meeting with Ms L Bird after mock examinations have finished.

Item 6 - Lower School Head Boy and Girl Update

Jasmine Howells (Head Girl) updated the group of the 'Drop In' sessions, which are due to start next week. She announced that there would be an alternating system, whereby one week is hosted by the Head Girl and Boy and the next week is hosted by the Deputy Head Girl and Boy.

She also agreed that the suggestion box initiative needs further impetus for its implementation. Charlie Korodi volunteered to hold the box as students are going into assemblies in order to garner feedback.

Item 7 - Student Leadership Display Board

Ms M Dukeson told the group that, after having no assistance from students, she had proceeded to put the board up herself, but acknowledged that it could be improved.

Abigail Hartley and Charlotte Womersley agreed to work with Ms M Dukeson to rejuvenate the board, and Student Leaders reiterated their commitment to send in 'selfies' to be put alongside their names on the board.

Item 8 - Message from GMR

Mr G Richardson expressed his disappointment that a large number of Student Leaders were not getting involved with out of school activities, such as representing the school. He argued that this makes up a large proportion of the role of a Student Leader. Student Leaders agreed to become more actively involved in the future.

Item 9 - Huddersfield Change Project

Ms M Dukeson informed the group that the deadline had passed from internal collection of the food donated by College for the Huddersfield Change Project. She said that she was in discussions to work out a place to store the food, and would make arrangements for it to be taken to the Huddersfield Change Project before Christmas.

Item 10 - Christmas Jumper Day

Ms M Dukeson reminded the group that the Lower School Christmas jumper day was on Friday 22nd December, and that the 6th Form Christmas jumper day was on Thursday 21st December. She agreed to distribute information regarding this to the wider student body.
